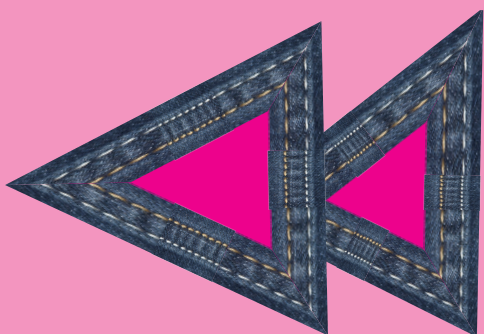


4 ways Indiana State Campus
